



ANNUAL PREA REPORT SUMMARY – 2017

RS EDEN's Recovery Services Division provides residential substance abuse treatment for men and women involved in the criminal justice system. In 2017, the Recovery Services Division started the process of becoming PREA compliant, which included finalization of a PREA Policy, staff training, and educating clients on RS EDEN's Zero Tolerance Policy on Sexual Abuse and Harassment.

Each year our residential facilities take into consideration that any substantial renovations will include PREA considerations. Our Reentry Ashland facility upgraded their camera system. Reentry West will update their camera system in 2018.

RS EDEN's Corrections and Recovery Service Divisions will have PREA Audits in March of 2018.
